

Day 1: Mr. Ashok Nepal discussed about his project Samaveshi

Samaaveshi: Building 'inclusive' classroom

ØVISION: One day, all schools will become 'inclusive'.

· Why 'inclusive education'?:

PROBLEM: Low enrolment and high dropout among children with disabilities (CWDs). In India, **34%** of all CWDs are out of the school of all CWDs enrolled in school, only **8.5%** make it to secondary level, and a dismal **2.3%** pursue higher secondary education. MHRD India 2016

SOLUTION: To bring systemic transformation in schools where all children irrespective of their social background or disability study together in the same classroom

• Strategic plan (2021-2031):

Samaaveshi pathshaala flagship programme is an 'inclusive school' in kashele village where 30 students (15 each in KG & Grade 1), including 10 children with disability, study together using a multi-sensory approach. Plan is to add one grade every academic year – grade X by 2030

INCLUSIVE 'ANGANWADIs':

Their idea is to transform anganwadis into an 'inclusive' early education center, by training anganwadi teachers in inclusive currently, we're working with 60 anganwadis. Their goal is to cover all 300 anganwadis in karjat, by 2025.

· COVID RESPONSE 2.0:

In 2020, they provided food and hygiene kits to 100+ tribal families. In 2021, they donated food supplies for 1-2 months to 250+ tribal families; and gave (1-1) oximeter & thermometer each to 60 anganwadis for better community preparedness in the remote village of karjat.

Day 2: KVN Rao emphasized on the importance of Entrepreneurship as a career opportunity for the young generation. During covid times, many people lost their jobs as the entire economy was affected. People started doing small business for their survival. Everyone should take entrepreneurship as a habit.Risk taking should become one of the factors for the development of an individual.
