The programme began with the students of the college singing Tagore's prayer song 'This is my prayer to Thee My Lord'. It was followed by a speech on Tagore's life given by Simrooz of BAIII. There were several dances, particularly one by the professional dancers, Harshita (BA III) & Durga (BA II). The students enacted a skit 'Dear Departed' by Stanley Houghton. The singers sang several Bengali songs. The programme gave the students an insight into the beauty of Tagore's works and brought an awareness of the Bengal art & culture.
