#### **OBJECTIVE**

Cancer is the second deadliest disease with highest mortality rate in the world. Every fourth to fifth person we meet around has chances of suffering with cancer or already is suffering with cancer. With change in lifestyle these days, there is also increased risk of the disease. The event is intended to enlighten the students and faculty around and spread awareness among common people on cancers.

#### **BRIEF ABOUT THE EVENT**

Three events were conducted. The event started with guest lecture of a medical practitioner where he gave various aspects with respect to cancer. The second half of the event was on quiz on biology and poster presentations on cancers by life science students.

#### **OUTCOME**

Students were addressed on various causes of cancer and how to prevent from causing any serious threat to life in future. A total of 60 life science students attended the quiz and at the end of 3<sup>rd</sup> round 3 teams were chosen with highest score and accuracy. 12 posters were presented by the life science students as a part of awareness.

#### **DETAILED REPORT:**

Cancer is a group of diseases characterized by unregulated cell growth and the invasion and spread of cells from the site of origin, or primary site, to other sites in the body. There are multiple cancers characterized based on their origin and tissue that is being invaded. Considering the utmost importance of knowledge required to educate selves, family and friends the event was focused on spreading awareness of cancers.

World cancer day is celebrated on 4<sup>th</sup> February every year. The event started with guest lecture by Dr P Ram Kumar, a specialist on Conservational Dentistry and Endodontics. He focused on the importance of healthy living and gave critical reason of why cancers are spread so high. He further mentioned on what are different causes and ways through which cancers spread around. He gave suggestions and what can be done to reduce to effect of cancers. Daily lifestyle changes and physical well being of a person is very important to fight against cancer. He described how and why it is not completely curable but how is it best prevented.

The second half of the day was organized with quiz session and poster presentation. A total of 60 students participated with 30 teams of two members per team. Three rounds were organized with the first one having 20 questions common for all. Teams with 50% of accuracy were taken to the second round. 12 teams entered the second round where the questions were to be answered in minimum time. Maximum accuracy in minimum time was the given criteria for round two. At the end of round two 6 teams were selected to finals. The final round is a rapid-fire round with 30 questions per group. Teams with the highest correct answers were declared as winner. At the end of third round 3 teams were choosen as winners, runner ups and second runner ups.

The poster presentation session was followed by the quiz session. A total of 12 posters were presented by students from various groups of life sciences. The posters depicted various aspects of cancers from what are cancers, classification of cancers to prevention and treatments being employed for cancers to treat them.

The session ended with valedictory and vote of thanks.
