

Dept. of Emergencey, Yashoda Hospitals explained the importance of Basic Life Support to the students with the help of powerpoint presentation and models. The objective of this initiative is to minimize the damage and loss during medical emergencies by training

students to administer immediate care to keep a patient stable until medical help arrives.

The AHA's BLS course trained participants to promptly recognize several life-threatening emergencies, give high-quality chest compressions, deliver appropriate ventilations and provide early use of an AED. Reflects science and education from the American Heart Association Guidelines Update for CPR and Emergency Cardiovascular Care (ECC).

The training session includes the following features:

- High-quality CPR for adults, children, and infants
- The AHA Chain of Survival, specifically the BLS components
- Important early use of an AED
- Effective ventilations using a barrier device
- Importance of teams in multirescuer resuscitation and performance as an effective team member during multirescuer CPR
- Relief of foreign-body airway obstruction (choking) for adults and infants



I took a nap until I was woken up by my mom for dinner, she asked me where my brother was, I was shocked and my heart started pounding real fast because I thought he would return home within an hour after not finding me. I told mom what all happened, she started freaking out and went to dad to tell him, then all of us headed to the woods looking for him, we looked everywhere for 3 long hours and returned to the farm house to check if he returned when we were out, we did not find him at the house too, mom broke down and Started crying out loud, tears rolled from my eyes too realising how big I screwed up this time.

Dad tried consoling my mom, it was already 12AM by now, we decided to get back to the woods looking for him, when we heard a sudden thud at the door as if someone has fallen, we opened the door to find my brother lying on the ground unconscious. Dad picked him up took him to the living room, I was scared to find the long scars on his hands and neck and bruises on his



head, it appeared like some monster has tried Beating him up to death, thank god we had a safety medical kit, we cleaned his scars and bruises and bandaged him up, we tried getting him into conscious, after trying for a couple of hours he got up and started screaming "NO...!! PLEASE LEAVE ME....!!" Mom hugged him and tried calming him down. He started crying and after a while he was still sobbing and breathing heavily. Mom however asked him what had happened. He was still traumatised, but he started telling what happened. He told he'd

went into the woods searching for me and he saw someone leaned to the tree. He thought it was me and headed towards the person, as he got close to him, the person started running deep into the woods. My brother assumed I was being playful and started chasing the person. He went too deep into the woods and was shocked to find that it was not me and it was someone else. 

The real story of how I started my cake business for a long time now. The actual, raw, uncensored story.

Welcome to draft no. 3... I've written, deleted, rewritten and deleted multiple drafts of a chapter that very (VERY) few know. Since childhood, I was always into art and craft. Creative things always excited me. At the age of 11, my sister who was a home baker taught me the basics of baking. It slowly became a hobby of mine. The first ever cake I made was for my brothers' birthday. Then slowly I started making cakes for my family members too. Back then I was in Inter 1st year[11th grade] and had a lot of free time, so I thought of converting my hobby into a business. So in 2017, I planned on opening my small business.

Things didn't go as planned at the start. The first 2 years were very difficult, as I had no knowledge of running a business or how to market my business. During the initial months, I used to bake free cakes for my friends and neighbours for some publicity. Gradually I got recognition and I started to get some orders.

For the first 2 years, I barely sold 100 cakes, but during the pandemic, I sold more than 300 cakes. I used to make at least 4-5 cakes per day. I got an amazing response during that time.

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Aftee the pandemic, college resumed and I did not get enough time to bake but I still managed to run my business just fine. I realised I didn't just want a job for the job's sake. I wanted to create. I wanted to bake. I wanted to be a girl boss (cause come on, that just sounds way cool). And call me immature, but I wanted to work at home in my pyjamas every day! So the decision was made and I went for it. I had set myself a steep learning curve but I was determined to make it work because I thought "If others can successfully carve out a career out of this, then I can too". This makes me want to share a few very important core mantras that saw me through the rough patches of my caking odyssey. There's always room at the top. The fact that there seem to be many, many others more successful than you, doesn't mean there isn't space for you to succeed too.

You have to have faith in it till you make it. Don't stop believing! It's actually possible to make a career out of something you love. When the doubts or fears hit, you just have to have "faith in it" and move forwards.

Nonetheless, I could see very clearly where I was, and where I wanted to be. So with determination in my heart I kept working away at my dream until it became a reality. I invested in courses and classes and acquired skills. I practised, perfected and honed my craft.

If you're telling yourself that dreams are for other people but not you, or that others have a better shot at it than you do, or if life's throwing you some serious punches...then I hope my story helps encourage you that dreams are achievable and they are doable.
